

Vacqueyras, Domaine Arnoux & Fils 2007 £33.50

A blend of 70% Grenache with Syrah and Mourvedre. Lots of seductive black cherry, plum and cassis fruit and subtle notes of herbs and spices. An uncluttered wine with a rustic local feel.

Barolo, Flori 2006 £35.50

With heady, maturing smoky aromas of dried fruit, leather, and earthy woodiness, this big red wine is rich, velvety and rustic with a characteristic dry, gripping finish.

Rioja, Martinez Lacuesta Reserva 2004 £46.25

A blend of Tempranillo, Graciano and Mazuelo, this wine has spent 30 months in new and semi-new oak and a further 36 months in bottle. The nose is powerful with elegant fruit and oak aromas, while on the palate subtle nuances from age are beginning to show.

Chateauneuf du Pape, Domaine de Panisse 2005 £48.95

Full, firm Chateauneuf; chewy and powerful.

Savigny-les-Beaunes, 1er cru Les Peuillets 2007 £66.75

Gloriously stylish red Burgundy; supple with flavours of ripe cherries and a distinctive, truffley character.

Amarone Classico del Fondatore 2007 £69.50

This wine shows a dense plum/black colour and has a complex nose showing notes of black cherry, plum fruit and violets. The palate is smooth and round with a rich raisiny character, supple tannins and a long, and complex, finish. Threatens to be sweet but in fact finishes quite dry.

Pommard, Clos des Epeneaux 2000 £128.54

Rich, stylish Red Burgundy, this is a wine of underlying power yet with great finesse. Silky smooth on the palate, with flavours of sweet red cherries and raspberries.

Dessert Wine

Late Harvest Sauvignon, Concha Y Toro 2009 £6.00 (125ml) £15.00

Golden yellow with amber tones, this sumptuous wine displays ripe papaya, peach and honey aromas. The palate is light, fresh and fruity with a long, subtle, honeyed finish.

Domaine de la Bastide, Cotes du Rhone 2010 Very stylish vin de pays from southern France. Has a lovely aroma of fresh apricots coupled with a fine, rich fruit on the palate and a crisp, zesty finish.			£20.95
Verdicchio, Coste del Molino 2009 A stylish concentrated wine made from 100% Verdicchio, with sweet herbaceous and pineapple aromas and a dry elegant feel.			£22.95
Sauvignon Blanc, Makutu 2010 This pale lemon wine shows lifted tropical notes of passionfruit and guava balanced by wet stone characters. The palate is full with sufficient weight and underlying flinty minerality followed by a long, dry and crisp finish.			£23.85
Pinot Grigio, Bottega Vinai 2009/10 Truly outstanding Pinot Grigio, beautifully balanced with a delightful concentration of flavour and a crispness on the finish.			£24.50
Petit Bourgeois Sauvignon Blanc 2009/10 From one of the top growers in Sancerre, this is a classic Loire Valley Sauvignon Blanc – crisp, aromatic and stylish. As the vineyards are outside the delimited area it cannot be called Sancerre but it enjoys the same tender care that Arnaud Bourgeois puts into his top wines.			£25.25
Chenin Blanc, Jordan Vineyards 2009/10 Partial barrel fermentation adds a spicy complexity to the tropical fruit and creamy citrus flavours of this gorgeous South African white.			£27.75
Suri, Monferrato Bianco 2009/10 Blend of Cortese, Chardonnay and a splash of Sauvignon Blanc. Organically farmed, this wine medium is bodied but has a zingy freshness with perfumed aromas of apples, flowers and limes and a lovely rounded palate.			£27.95
Gruner Veltliner, Wiener Berge, Weingut Wieninger 2009 Classic Gruner Veltliner with a fine, crisp, “green apple” character married with hints of white pepper.			£31.00
Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux 2008 Very stylish Chablis that is typically dry and flinty with citrus flavours on the finish.			£32.00
Pouilly Fume, Domaine Henri Bourgeois 2008 Delightful Loire white, slightly smokey with aromas of gooseberries and fresh blackcurrants.			£37.00
Albarino, Pazo de Senorans 2009 One of Spain’s finest white wines, beautifully balanced, aromatic and perfect with seafood.			£42.50
Chablis 1er Cru, Vaillons 2001 Daniel-Etienne Defaix released his 2001 vintage for the first time in 2009, true to his principle of long term ageing of his wines on the lees so as to build in complexity. The Vaillons has attractive notes of lemon grass and a scintillating mineral finish.			£69.50
Meursault, 1er cru Blagny, Thomas 2004 Beautifully balanced white Burgundy from one of the region’s most celebrated growers. Rich and intense with flavours of minerals and citrus fruits combined with toasty oak.			£85.00

Puligny Montrachet, 1er Cru La Quintessence, Matrot 2006 **£110.00**
This rich and powerful wine is the result of the blending of two Premiers Crus from the slopes of Puligny. Fresh almonds and white flowers dominate the bouquet. The round and rich palate displays aromas of dry fruits, which are accentuated by the elegant minerality of this Premier Cru.

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Chianti, Prunatelli 2009 This Chianti has a very pretty nose of cherries and almonds, with an underlying smoky edge. The palate is brimming with soft, ripe juicy cherry fruit, with soft, chalky tannins and fine acidity giving great balance.			£21.50
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Pinot Noir, Waipara Hills 2009 The nose has lifted aromas of plums, dark cherries, leather and dried spice enhance the immediate appeal of this wine. Initially soft and silky in the mouth, this opens up to give a full, rich structure on the palate with dark red fruits, dried spice and lingering leather characteristics.			£22.50
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Suri, Barbera d’Asti 2009 Ruby red in colour and full of the fine intensity typical of Barbera, this wine presents aromas of spring flowers, bitter cherry and leather. On the palate it is full bodied and fruit with a long, intense finish.			£27.95
